

In-kind Donation

Overview

Gifts In-kind, also referred to as In-kind donations, is a type of charitable giving. Instead of giving money to buy needed goods and services, the goods and services themselves are given.

If you itemize deductions you can deduct the fair market value of physical items you contribute and the miles driven for charitable purposes.

Examples

Property Donations are anything that is a non-perishable such as buildings, land, computers, equipment, furniture, and clothes.

Service Donations include things like advertising, or professional services (accounting, legal).

Goods and Supplies Donations include items like office supplies (copy paper, legal pad, pens pencils, etc..).
